For the Teacher

Overview of Grade K, Life Science, Engagement 3

A series of interactive screens provides students with opportunities to identify, order, and sort to classify. One at a time, students volunteer to guide the teacher by stating where to place text labels or small images on the screen.

What You Need

The means to project this interactive for whole-class viewing

Advance Preparation

Plan a way to keep track of which students have already answered and which students are still eligible for a turn. Collectively, the screens include thirty words or images to drag and drop, so each student in the class should get at least one turn.

How to Facilitate

- Beginning with the screen following this one, project the engagement in the largest format possible for whole-class viewing.
- Go over expectations with students before beginning.
- Clicking on speaker buttons and larger blocks of text activates voice audio of the text. Or, you may choose to do the reading aloud for students.
- For tasks that involve placing text labels, identify a term. Point the word out to students, and pronounce it aloud for them.
- Select a volunteer to guide you as you drag and drop each term or image to the target on the screen that the student identifies.
- Check the answers, and choose **Next** to continue to the next screen.
